We are looking forward to a very productive year with a strategic planning session scheduled for February 2015. This will set the blue print for the direction of CCLO over the coming 2-3 years. In addition to Toukley, preliminary work is underway so that the construction of Stage 1 Supported Accommodation can begin on property owned by CCLO at Gorokan as soon as possible. There is still much to be done before Gorokan becomes a reality but nothing ever eventuates unless plans are in place.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank CEO Kevin Johnston for his exceptional work over the past few months, and Operations Manager, Lee-anne Hollis for her untiring efforts for CCLO clients. All CCLO Staff are a wonderful asset to our organisation and sincere thanks go to them from all on the Board of Management.
