The end of another financial year has rolled around and the CCLO Management Team is busily preparing for it with final account preparations leading to our Audit and Annual General Meeting later in the year.

It seems as though every year passes more quickly than the one before, probably due to our Group's increased activity, staff and client numbers.

As our Chairlady stated in her message, we will achieve results very close to our budgeted expectations.

In this "new age" of NDIS funding it is imperative that NFP Groups such as ourselves, keep a very close eye on the "bottom line" in order to be sustainable and to continue our work with NDIS Participants.

Due to the NDIS dictating our hourly rates on all of our provided services, the only way we are able to obtain a surplus, to put into further housing construction and increased services, is to closely monitor our expense levels and this we strive to do daily.

Positive Financial outcomes are necessary, but is not the only measure of a flourishing Service. Over the past 12 months we have successfully completed and accomplished many milestones.

Some of them are:

- The commencement of construction for Stage 1of our new 5 bedroom Group Home at Gorokan with completion expected this August.
- Stage 2 on this site will commence on completion of Stage1.
- The growth of our Co-Ordination of Support activities to 56 Clients.
- The further development of our Community Access activities where we now support around 60 Clients.
- The further roll out of our Client Relationship Management (CRM) system and the integration of it with an automated pay roll system.
- Staff numbers grew from 70 to 94.
- Our transport fleet grew from 7 to 12 vehicles.
- We settled on a further property at 12 Victoria Ave Toukley. This is accommodation for a further 4 persons.
- Overall we now have 6 properties, counting the new Gorokan property, with further exciting housing developments to come.

All of our positive achievements would not have been possible without the great support of our Board of Management, Care Staff, Participants and their families and friends and to them I extend a big "Thank you" and look forward to another positive financial year ahead.
